

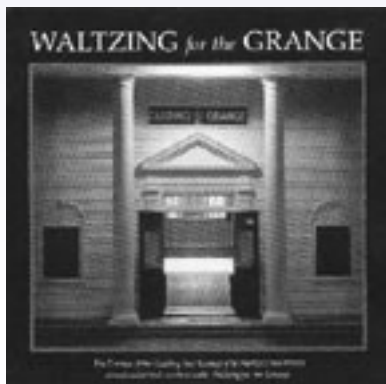

Who are the Friends of the Guiding Star Grange?

The Friends of the Guiding Star Grange is an organization whose purpose is to ensure the long-term sustainability of the Grange building, to promote and support the development of cultural programs that encourage music and dance in the building, and to facilitate cooperation between music and dance community members and the Grange. We are a separate organization from the Grange itself, but work closely with the Grange to accomplish a number of common goals.

We do this in several ways: raising money, by means of benefit dances and other fundraisers, which will be used by the Grange to improve and maintain the Grange hall; sponsoring a variety of dances, workshops and other events which promote music, dance, and other arts in the community; physically helping maintain the Grange facilities by organizing the annual spring cleanup day; and raising awareness of various issues of interest to the dance community.

Recent and upcoming projects supported in part by funds from the Friends include the upgraded kitchen and bathrooms, heating and ventilation systems, improved accessibility, and the eagerly awaited new dance floor!
